Joshua Eisenman

SENIOR FELLOW IN CHINA STUDIES

Dr. Joshua Eisenman is senior fellow for China studies at the American Foreign Policy Council (AFPC) in Washington, DC and assistant professor at the University of Texas-Austin's Lyndon Baines Johnson School of Public Affairs. Before joining the AFPC in 2006 he served for two and half years as a professional policy analyst on the Congressionally-mandated U.S.-China Economic and Security Review Commission. He has also worked as fellow at the New America Foundation and assistant director of China studies at the Center for the National Interest (formally The Nixon Center). Dr. Eisenman's second book, *China and Africa: A Century of Engagement* (University of Pennsylvania Press) coauthored with former U.S. Ambassador to Ethiopia David H. Shinn, was named one of the top three books on Africa in 2012 by *Foreign Affairs* magazine. In 2007, he co-edited *China and the Developing World: Beijing's Strategy for the 21st Century* (ME Sharpe) with U.S. Ambassador to Myanmar Derek J. Mitchell. His work on Chinese politics and international relations has appeared in *The National Interest*, *Current History*, the *International Herald Tribune*, the *Asian Wall Street Journal*, and *Newsweek*. Dr. Eisenman has lectured at numerous venues around the world, including the Council on Foreign Relations, Harvard University, the Asia Society in Hong Kong, and the Central Party School of the Central Committee of the Communist Party of China.

Dr. Eisenman holds a PhD in political science from the University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA), an MA in International Relations from Johns Hopkins University's Paul H. Nitze School of Advanced International Studies (SAIS), and a BA in East Asian Studies from The George Washington University's Elliott School of International Affairs.
